Baggage Mandate: OVERSIZED XL DUFFEL BAGS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED THIS SUMMER

As the impact of COVID-19 continues, there has been a significant surge in shipping volume for the common carriers (UPS & FedEx), especially for oversize, hard-to-handle packages. As a result, both UPS & FedEx have imposed new & very costly surcharges which is impacting pricing for all consumers.

In an effort to keep shipping costs down, ShiptoCamp along with Camp Barney Medintz have instituted the following mandate limiting baggage size to simplify the baggage handling process for our collective staffs.

For all local and out-of-state pickups, please note that all bags will be weighed and measured. Bags **should not exceed 40x20x20 "when fully packed"** with a max weight of 50 lbs. when fully packed.

Any bags exceeding 120 total dimensional inches may be subject to OVERSIZE handling fees.

Dimensional inches are calculated as follows: Length + 2x Width + 2x Height (when fully packed)

ShiptoCamp reserves the right to refuse and **NOT** transport any Oversize duffel bag(s) without the acknowledgement of the camper family accepting 100% responsibility to pay for any and all Oversize Surcharges.

WE ARE HIGHLY ENCOURAGING ALL FAMILIES TO FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES TO AVOID SIGNIFICANT INCREASES IN COST.
